

## Delmarva Maryland SOS Bid Results from October 20, 2008 Solicitation

### Delmarva Residential and Small Commercial

This solicitation included the Residential and Small Commercial 24-Month term starting June 1, 2009 through May 31, 2011.

A total of three (3) bid blocks were offered representing 25.0 % of the load, and totaling approximately 144.9 MW PLC at time of Bid. None of the requirements were filled.

There were 13 eligible bidders in the 2009– 2010 RFP Procurement Process of which 7 suppliers submitted bids.

## Delmarva Type II Non Residential

This solicitation also included the second quarter 2008 Type II Non Residential, three month term for September 2008, October 2008, and November 2008.

A total of one (1) bid block was offered representing 100% of the load and approximately 61.8 MW PLC at time of Bid. This requirement was filled.

There were 16 eligible bidders in the 2008 – 2009 RFP Procurement Process of which 4 suppliers submitted bids and 1 supplier won the load offered.
