

## Delmarva Maryland SOS Bid Results from April 20, 2009 Solicitation

### Delmarva Residential and Small Commercial

This solicitation included the Residential and Small Commercial 24-Month term starting October 1, 2009 through September 30, 2011.

A total of three (3) bid blocks were offered representing 25.0 % of the load, and totaling approximately 144.9 MW PLC at time of Bid. All requirements were filled.

There were 13 eligible bidders in the 2009– 2010 RFP Procurement Process of which 6 suppliers submitted bids and 2 suppliers won the load offered.

## Delmarva Type II Non Residential

This solicitation also included the first quarter 2009 Type II Non Residential, three month term for June 2009, July 2009, and August 2009.

A total of one (1) bid block was offered representing 100% of the load and approximately 55.4 MW PLC at time of Bid. This requirement was filled.

There were 13 eligible bidders in the 2009 – 2010 RFP Procurement Process of which 5 suppliers submitted bids and 1 supplier won the load offered.
