

Delmarva Maryland SOS Bid Results from April 19, 2010 Solicitation

Delmarva Residential and Small Commercial

This solicitation included the Residential and Small Commercial 24-Month term starting October 1, 2010 through September 30, 2012.

A total of three (3) bid blocks were offered representing 31.1% of the load, and totaling approximately 162.6 MW PLC at time of Bid. All requirements were filled.

There were 13 eligible bidders in the 2010– 2011 RFP Procurement Process of which 7 suppliers submitted bids and 2 suppliers won a portion of the load offered.

This solicitation also included the first quarter 2010, three month term for June, July, and August 2010.

A total of two (2) bid blocks was offered representing 100% of the load and approximately 76.8 MW PLC at time of Bid. This requirement was filled.

There were 13 eligible bidders in the 2010 – 2011 RFP Procurement Process of which 6 suppliers submitted bids and 1 supplier won the total load offered.
