

## Delmarva Maryland SOS Bid Results from October 19, 2009 Solicitation

### Delmarva Residential and Small Commercial

This solicitation included the Residential and Small Commercial 24-Month term starting June 1, 2010 through May 31, 2012.

A total of two (2) bid blocks were offered representing 18.9% of the load, and totaling approximately 98.6 MW PLC at time of Bid. All requirements were filled.

There were 11 eligible bidders in the 2010– 2011 RFP Procurement Process of which 7 suppliers submitted bids and 2 suppliers won a portion of the load offered.

## Delmarva Type II Non Residential

This solicitation also included the Third quarter 2009, three month term for December 2009, January 2010, and February 2010.

A total of two (2) bid blocks was offered representing 100% of the load and approximately 78.0 MW PLC at time of Bid. This requirement was filled.

There were 13 eligible bidders in the 2009 – 2010 RFP Procurement Process of which 7 suppliers submitted bids and 2 suppliers won a portion of the load offered.
