

## Delmarva Maryland SOS Bid Results from October 25, 2010 Solicitation

### Delmarva Residential and Small Commercial

This solicitation included the Residential and Small Commercial 24-Month term starting June 1, 2011 through May 31, 2013.

A total of three (3) bid blocks were offered representing 25% of the load, and totaling approximately 129.0 MW PLC at time of Bid. All requirements were filled.

There were 9 eligible bidders in the 2011– 2012 RFP Procurement Process of which 5 suppliers submitted bids and 3 suppliers won a portion of the load offered.

## Delmarva Type II Non Residential

This solicitation also included the quarter containing the three month term for December 2010, January 2011, and February 2011.

A total of two (2) bid blocks was offered representing 100% of the load and approximately 74.2 MW PLC at time of Bid. This requirement was filled.

There were 9 eligible bidders in the 2011 – 2012 RFP Procurement Process of which 6 suppliers submitted bids and 1 supplier won the entire load offered.
