

## Delmarva Maryland SOS Bid Results from October 24, 2011 Solicitation

### Delmarva Residential and Small Commercial

This solicitation included the Residential and Small Commercial 24-Month term starting June 1, 2012 through May 31, 2014.

A total of two (2) bid blocks were offered representing 18.9% of the load, and totaling approximately 97.8 MW PLC at time of Bid. All requirements were filled.

There were 10 eligible bidders in the 2012– 2013 RFP Procurement Process of which 6 suppliers submitted bids and 1 supplier won the entire load offered.

## Delmarva Type II Non Residential

This solicitation also included the quarter containing the three month term for December 2011, January 2012, and February 2012.

A total of two (2) bid blocks were offered representing 100% of the load and approximately 67.2 MW PLC at time of Bid. This requirement was filled.

There were 10 eligible bidders in the 2012 – 2013 RFP Procurement Process of which 6 suppliers submitted bids and 1 supplier won the entire load offered.
