

Pepco Maryland SOS Bid Results from October 20, 2008 Solicitation

Pepco Residential and Small Commercial

This solicitation included the Residential and Small Commercial 24-Month term starting June 1, 2009 through May 31, 2011.

A total of eight (8) bid blocks were offered representing 25.0% of the load and totaling approximately 408.8 MW PLC at time of Bid. All requirements were filled.

There were 15 eligible bidders in the 2009 – 2010 RFP Procurement Process of which 11 suppliers submitted bids and 3 suppliers won a portion of the load offered.

Pepco Type II Non Residential

This solicitation also included the second quarter 2008, three month term for September 2008, October 2008, and November 2008.

A total of seven (7) bid blocks were offered representing 100% of the load and totaling approximately 357 MW PLC at time of Bid. All requirements were filled.

There were 18 eligible bidders in the 2008 – 2009 RFP Procurement Process of which 8 suppliers submitted bids and 3 suppliers won the load offered.
