

## Pepco Maryland SOS Bid Results from April 20, 2009 Solicitation

### Pepco Residential and Small Commercial

This solicitation included the Residential and Small Commercial 24-Month term starting October 1, 2009 through September 30, 2011.

A total of eight (8) bid blocks were offered representing 25.0% of the load and totaling approximately 409.6 MW PLC at time of Bid. All requirements were filled.

There were 15 eligible bidders in the 2009 – 2010 RFP Procurement Process of which 7 suppliers submitted bids and 4 suppliers won a portion of the load offered.

## Pepco Type II Non Residential

This solicitation also included the first quarter 2009 Type II Non Residential, three month term for June 2009, July 2009, and August 2009.

A total of seven (7) bid blocks were offered representing 100% of the load and totaling approximately 331.8 MW PLC at time of Bid. All requirements were filled.

There were 15 eligible bidders in the 2009 – 2010 RFP Procurement Process of which 6 suppliers submitted bids and 3 suppliers won the load offered.
