

Pepco Maryland SOS Bid Results from April 21, 2008 Solicitation

Pepco Residential and Small Commercial

This solicitation included the Residential and Small Commercial 24-Month term starting October 1, 2008 through September 30, 2010.

A total of nine (9) bid blocks were offered representing 29.7% of the load and totaling approximately 462.6 MW PLC at time of Bid. All requirements were filled.

There were 18 eligible bidders in the 2008 – 2009 RFP Procurement Process of which 11 suppliers submitted bids and 4 suppliers won a portion of the load offered.

This solicitation also included the first quarter 2008, three month term for June 2008, July 2008, and August 2008.

A total of six (6) bid blocks were offered representing 100% of the load and totaling approximately 319.8 MW PLC at time of Bid. All requirements were filled.

There were 18 eligible bidders in the 2008 – 2009 RFP Procurement Process of which 6 suppliers submitted bids and 1 supplier won the load offered.
