

Pepco Maryland SOS Bid Results from October 19, 2009 Solicitation

Pepco Residential and Small Commercial

This solicitation included the Residential and Small Commercial 24-Month term starting June 1, 2010 through May 31, 2012.

A total of six (6) bid blocks were offered representing 20.3.0% of the load and totaling approximately 310.8 MW PLC at time of Bid. All requirements were filled.

There were 12 eligible bidders in the 2010 – 2011 RFP Procurement Process of which 9 suppliers submitted bids and 1 supplier won the load offered.

This solicitation also included the Third quarter 2009, three month term for December 2009, January 2010, and February 2010.

A total of six (6) bid blocks were offered representing 100% of the load and totaling approximately 305.4 MW PLC at time of Bid. All requirements were filled.

There were 15 eligible bidders in the 2009 – 2010 RFP Procurement Process of which 7 suppliers submitted bids and 3 suppliers won a portion of the load offered.
