

Pepco Maryland SOS Bid Results from October 25, 2010 Solicitation

Pepco Residential and Small Commercial

This solicitation included the Residential and Small Commercial 24-Month term starting June 1, 2011 through May 31, 2013.

A total of seven (7) bid blocks were offered representing 25% of the load and totaling approximately 349.3 MW PLC at time of Bid. All requirements were filled.

There were 11 eligible bidders in the 2011 – 2012 RFP Procurement Process of which 6 suppliers submitted bids and 2 suppliers won a portion of the load offered.

Pepco Type II Non Residential

This solicitation also included the quarter containing the three month term for December 2010, January 2011, and February 2011.

A total of five (5) bid blocks were offered representing 100% of the load and totaling approximately 264.5 MW PLC at time of Bid. All requirements were filled.

There were 11 eligible bidders in the 2011– 2012 RFP Procurement Process of which 8 suppliers submitted bids and 2 suppliers won a portion of the load offered.
