

Pepco Maryland SOS Bid Results from October 24, 2011 Solicitation

Pepco Residential and Small Commercial

This solicitation included the Residential and Small Commercial 24-Month term starting June 1, 2012 through May 31, 2014.

A total of six (6) bid blocks were offered representing 20.3% of the load and totaling approximately 274.8 MW PLC at time of Bid. All requirements were filled.

There were 12 eligible bidders in the 2012 – 2013 RFP Procurement Process of which 8 suppliers submitted bids and 3 suppliers won a portion of the load offered.

Pepco Type II Non Residential

This solicitation also included the quarter containing the three month term for December 2011, January 2012, and February 2012.

A total of five (5) bid blocks were offered representing 100% of the load and totaling approximately 265.5 MW PLC at time of Bid. All requirements were filled.

There were 12 eligible bidders in the 2012– 2013 RFP Procurement Process of which 7 suppliers submitted bids and 2 suppliers won a portion of the load offered.
